How does our faith (Christian worldview) affect our daily life? As Christians, our Biblical beliefs should be evident in all aspects of our life, from our church life, to our individual life, to our family life, to our work life. First, a worldview is the framework from which we understand our purpose for our life. A Christian worldview, where one's primary reason for existence is to love and serve God, is the standard by which we measure everything we do. As we start a new "Church Year", let's take a look at some specific areas of our life to see if our Christian worldview and beliefs are controlling our actions.

1. **Morality** - the Bible is very clear on issues such as marriage (Genesis 2:21-25; Hebrews 17:4), homosexuality (Leviticus 18:22 & 20:13) and abortion (Jeremiah 1:5, Psalm 127:3 & 139:13-16). The world wants to abolish these principles and say that marriage is not just for a man and woman or that a woman has the "right" to do to her body what she wants. Politicians love to use these issues to sway us from one side to the other. Will your worldview on moral issues affect your vote this year? Does your worldview affect the TV shows you watch, the music you listen to?
2. **Family life** - Men, are you the spiritual leader in your family? You should be! Do you regularly attend church with your family? Do you have family time where you read the Bible and discuss spiritual issues? Men are you teaching your sons how to be Christian young men? Women are you teaching your daughters to be Godly young women? Parents, YOU should be their example, not MTV, some pop star or immoral famous personality.
3. **Finances** - Do we REALLY trust God enough to give Him 10% and live on 90%? And, do we spend that 90% in a Biblical worldview way? We need to take an inventory in our homes and see how much "unnecessary stuff" we have. Did we spend God's 10% on that stuff or did we spend money that could have been used to make a difference in someone's life by giving it to the church or to a reputable charity?
4. **Work** - Does our Christian worldview affect our professional life? Would our co-workers have enough "evidence" against us to convict us of being a Christian? As someone who claims to love and follow Christ, we should be the best employee that anyone could have. Giving full-time work for full-time pay, making sure we do A+ work on every project, not stealing time or items from our employer - this is "evidence" we want our co-workers to have on us.
5. **Church Service** - We all have gifts that the church needs. Are you using your gift here at Stewartsville Baptist this year? EVERY member's name should be on our list of servants for 2012-13. Sunday School teacher, Nursery worker, Social committee member, Building/Grounds committee member, Choir member - just a few of the areas you can serve. Are you a part of the 20% that does 80% of the work or part of the 80% that only does 20% of the work. The Christian life is a life of SERVICE.

Take a few moments to ponder on these things as we look forward to a great church year. Keep our Pastor Search Committee in your prayers as they seek a pastor to lead us in the coming year.
